(Alma 7:14)

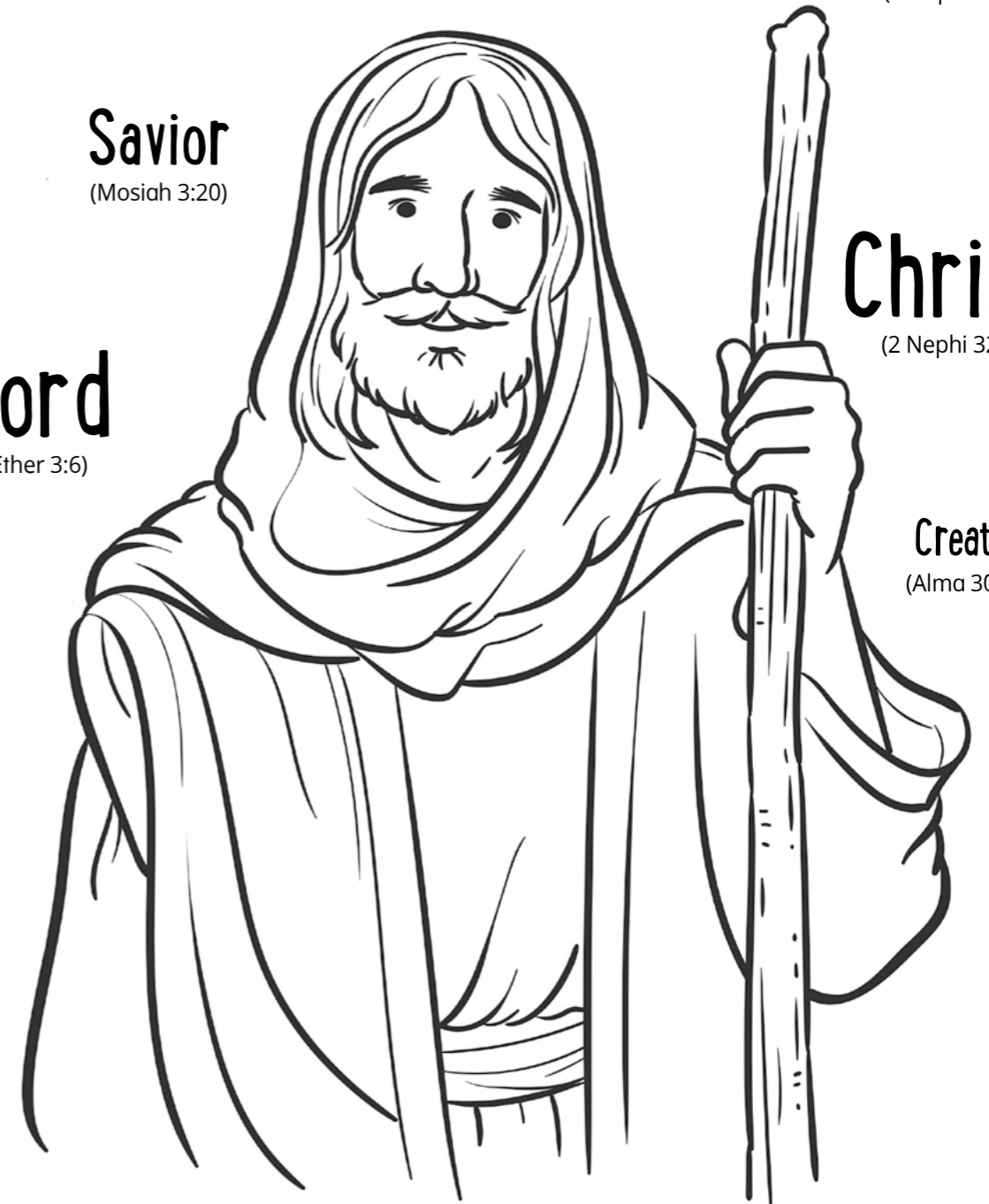
**Messiah**
