## Help Young People Serve Missions

- To help more young people choose to serve missions, successful stake presidents and bishops:
  1. Make serving a mission a top priority.
  2. Have a personal conviction about missionaries fulfilling their purpose.
  3. Know and love each youth and young single adult.
  4. Develop a missionary culture within their ward or stake.
  5. Are accountable and help others be accountable for preparing young people to serve missions.



## Members and Missionaries Work Together to Help Interested Friends Progress

- Every week, during the “brief, informal” missionary coordination meeting, members and missionaries “coordinate efforts to share the gospel and strengthen new and returning members” (see *General Handbook* 23.5.7).
