# DECEMBER 18: Manger

Luke 2:1-7: A manger is a box that holds food for animals. On the night of Jesus's birth, Mary "laid [the Savior] in a manger; because there was no room for them in the inn."

### **DECEMBER 21:** Shepherds

Luke 2:15-20: After receiving the news of the Savior's birth, the shepherds "came with haste" to see the Savior and then shared the good news with others.

## DECEMBER 20: Angel

Luke 2:8-14: An angel declared the news of the Savior's birth to shepherds guarding their flocks. **DECEMBER 19**
