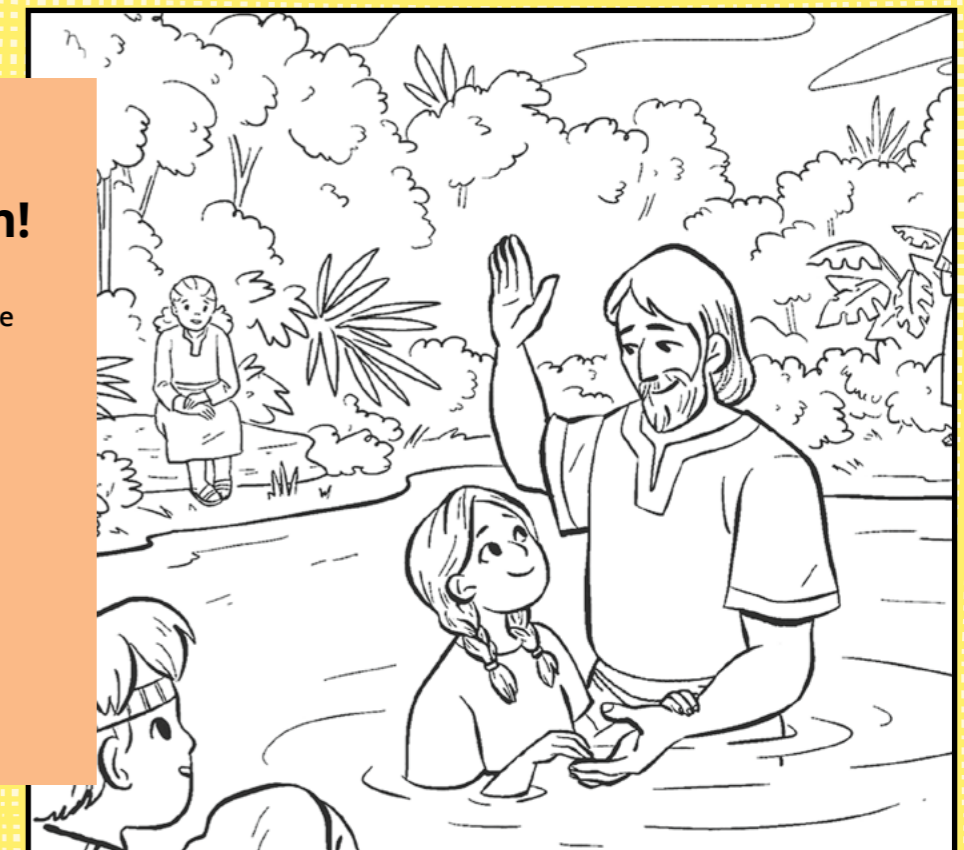
After you read, color part of the picture. You can read these scriptures that go along with each week's reading from *Come, Follow Me*.
