
Floods happen often in Papua New Guinea. So church buildings there are built on stilts. When a flood comes, members can paddle their canoes right up to the door!

Giant Butterflies

Chicken Pot

This is a traditional recipe in Papua New Guinea. Here is a version you can try!

- 1. Place **2 1/2 pounds** (1 kg) chopped chicken in a pot and add 1/2 tablespoon cooking oil. Add 1 teaspoon of curry powder and 1 teaspoon of salt.
- 2. Chop 1 sweet potato (or vegetable of choice) and 1 bunch of green onions. Add to pot with 1 cup corn
- 3. Pour **1/2 cup coconut cream** over vegetables and meat. Cover pot and bring to a low boil. Simmer for 30-40

4. Remove from heat. Add salt to taste.
