

Sample Itinerary: Groups with Youth and Children

Day 1

If you only have one day to explore Nauvoo, we recommend you go to these places.

1 Historic Nauvoo Visitors' Center

(1 hr) P ♿

Museum exhibits offer a fun and informative introduction to Nauvoo for all ages. Be sure to ask for an activity booklet at the welcome desk!

26 Wagon Ride

(30 min) P

Explore Nauvoo with our family favorite horse-drawn wagon rides.

9 Temple City

(1 hr) P

Enjoy guided home tours and hands-on activities while learning about the design and construction of the Nauvoo Temple.

5 Nauvoo Illinois Temple

(1 hr) P ♿

Visit the reconstructed Nauvoo Illinois Temple where Church members with current temple recommends can perform ordinances. Appointments are recommended.

Day 2

Staying longer in Nauvoo? Discover more of the historic sites on your second day.

39 Joseph and Emma Smith

(1 hr 30 min) P ♿

Tour Joseph Smith's historic homes and store, then visit the Smith family cemetery.

25 Family Living Center

(1 hr 30 min) P ♿

Discover pioneer arts, crafts, cooking, barrel making, and more.

24 Pastimes Pavilion

(1 hr 30 min) ♿

Children of all ages can enjoy outdoor toys and games from the 1840s.

Carthage Jail

(45 min) P ♿

Contemplate the legacy of Joseph and Hyrum Smith in the place they spent their final days.

(30 min drive east of Nauvoo)

Day 3

There's so much more to do on your third day exploring Historic Nauvoo.

34 Pioneer Trail

(2 hrs) P ♿

Learn about the preparation required to evacuate Nauvoo on a guided tour, then take a walk along the Trail of Hope down Parley Street to the Mississippi River.

29 Main Street Trades

(2 hrs) P ♿

Visit the homes and shops at the heart of Nauvoo's Main Street, and watch volunteers demonstrate skills of various trades.

28 Carriage Ride

(45 min) P

Take a ride in a horse-drawn carriage. With multiple route options, there's always more to explore!

14 Homes of the Apostles

(1 hr 30 min) P ♿

Take a guided tour of the homes of these early apostles and learn more about their missionary service.

Day 4+

Extending your stay lets you see everything Nauvoo has to offer.

17 Relief Society Foundations

(1 hr) P

Tour the Hiram and Sarah Granger Kimball Home and the Lucy Mack Smith Home to learn about the early days of the Relief Society.

27 Oxen Experience

(30 min) P

Meet live oxen and understand the role these gentle giants played in the trek west.

20 Pioneer Life

(45 min) P ♿

Take a guided tour and get a glimpse into everyday pioneer life.

8 Pioneer Cemetery

(30 min)

Take a quiet stroll in the Pioneer Cemetery. Looking for a relative? The FamilySearch Center in Nauvoo can help.
