TURN THEM AWAY?

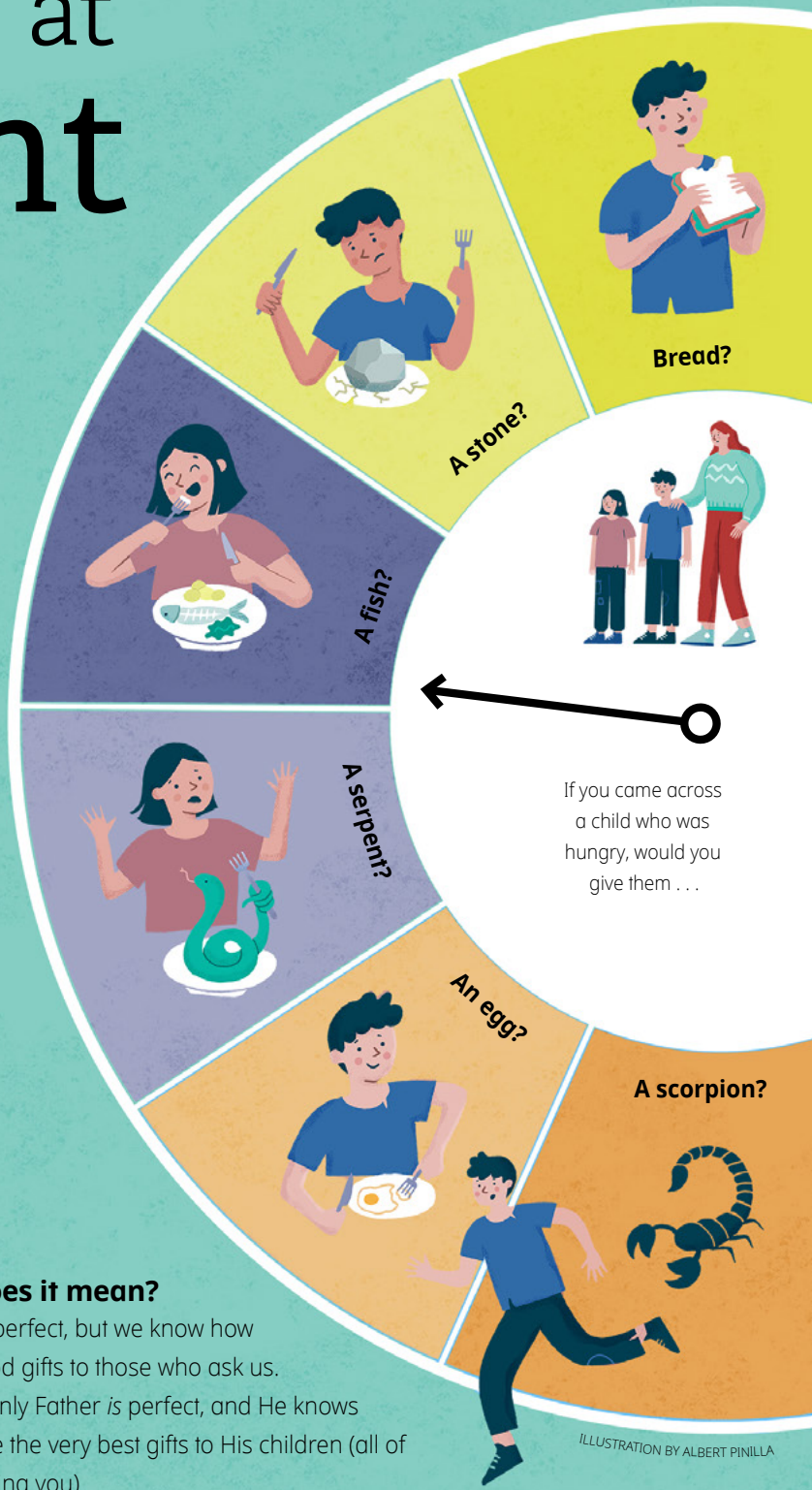
THE ANSWER:
