Ko Sīsū Kalaisi ‘a hotau fa’ifa’itaki’anga lelei tahá, “a ia [na‘á] ne kātaki ‘a e pekia ‘i he ‘akaú . . . ko e me‘a ‘i he fiefia na‘e tuku ‘i hono ‘aó” [Hepelū 12:2]. Fakakaukau ki ai!
