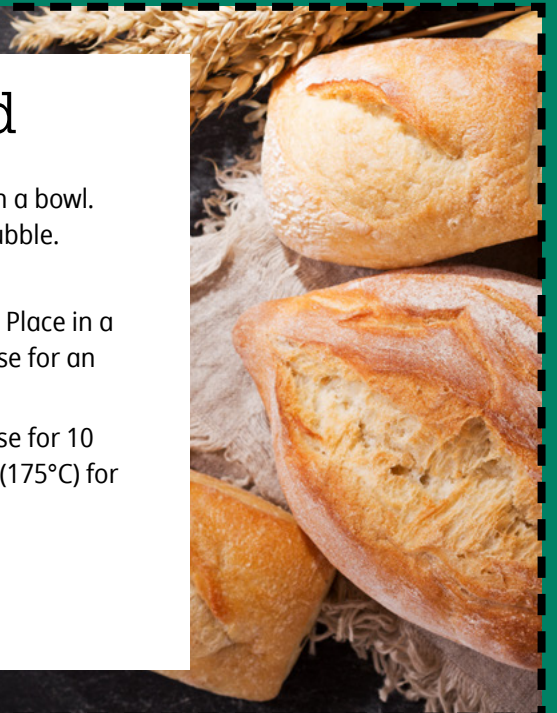
Faith is like a seed because it can grow a little at a time.

Make Your Own Bread

- 1 cup warm water
- 2 1/4 teaspoons dry yeast
- 2 tablespoons white sugar
- 3 cups flour
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 cup vegetable oil

1. Mix water, yeast, and sugar in a bowl. Wait 5 minutes for yeast to bubble.
2. Mix in flour, salt, and oil.
3. Knead dough for 10 minutes. Place in a greased pan. Cover and let rise for an hour.
4. Punch dough down and let rise for 10 more minutes. Bake at 350°F (175°C) for 30-40 minutes.
