



Sixth Crossing and Martin’s Cove Trek Itinerary

Get a broader understanding of the entire 1856 rescue story by trekking at the separate locations where rescuers found the Willie Company (Sixth Crossing) and where they helped shelter the Martin Company (Martin’s Cove).

Total walking distance: 13 miles.

You will be assigned a campground at either Martin’s Cove or Sixth Crossing based on availability.</p> <p>Optional Activity</p> <p>Visit other local overland trail sites or museums such as the Martin’s Cove or Sixth Crossing Visitors’ Centers.</p>	<p>Trek</p> <p>Pull handcarts in a 6.5-mile loop at either Martin’s Cove or Sixth Crossing. You will be assigned which day to trek at which location.</p> <p>Optional Activity</p> <p>Square dance near your campground; you supply the music and the caller.</p>	<p>Trek</p> <p>Pull handcarts at the other location.</p> <p>Optional Activity</p> <p>Visit other local overland trail sites or museums such as the Martin’s Cove or Sixth Crossing Visitors’ Centers.</p>	<p>Checkout</p> <p>Checkout by 11 am.</p> <p>Optional Activity</p> <p>Visit Rock Creek Hollow and use an amphitheater for a devotional or testimony meeting.</p>
