Needs

Many members and friends of the Church around the world want to improve their lives through a university education but can't afford or access it. BYU–Pathway Worldwide is available in more than 180 countries and provides access to university degrees that are faith-based, low-cost, and completely online.

Earning a degree through BYU–Pathway helps students increase their spiritual and temporal self-reliance. Better employment gives them more time to be with their families, to worship, and to serve.



Description

BYU–Pathway Worldwide provides access to online, low-cost degrees from BYU–Idaho and Ensign College. Bachelor's degrees can be completed in three years or less. All students qualify for 10–50% tuition discounts.

Preferred Path

Most students begin with three terms called PathwayConnect. This path offers the lowest tuition rate. These online academic and religious institute courses teach students foundational skills that help them increase educational success.

Students also gather in groups once a week, either virtually or at a local church building. Here they build friendships and get extra support from service missionaries.

Advanced Path

Students with previous university experience can also [enter directly](#) into an online degree program. Each bachelor's degree is built with three certificates and an associate degree. Students learn marketable skills along the way that can help them get a better job.
