

Sixth Crossing to Rock Creek Hollow Trek Itinerary

Walk a trail from the sixth crossing of the Sweetwater River, over Rocky Ridge, to Rock Creek Hollow. Your group will camp at different locations each night. This route is similar to the trail used by the Willie company and their rescuers in 1856.

Total walking distance: 28 miles
