

## Sixth Crossing and Rocky Ridge Trek Itinerary

Experience two of the most significant places related to the rescue of the Willie Company: Sixth Crossing and Rocky Ridge. The Willie company camped at the sixth crossing of the Sweetwater River while waiting for rescuers to arrive. Two days after the rescuers reached them, the company members traversed Rocky Ridge; this was one of the most trying experiences of their journey.

Drive back to Sixth Crossing.</p>	<p><b>Checkout</b></p> <p>Checkout before 11 am.</p> <p><b>Optional Activity</b></p> <p>Visit Rock Creek Hollow and use an amphitheater for a devotional or testimony meeting.</p>
